SAWTRY WAY (B1090) SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION PROJECT

Having consulted face-to-face with most business owners and many residents about our original proposal to lower the speed limits along Sawtry **we have been convinced that** the original idea of a limit of 50/40 mph and switching speed limits is still too unsafe and/or confusing and would not significantly lower the vibration/noise levels.

Additionally, the accident numbers and potential threat to life for B1090 road users at the A141/B1090 roundabout were brought to our attention with a request to include it.

Consequently, in response to this strong, proactive level of solid support for the project, the Board of Directors of Community Roadwatch has requested County funding in its Local Highways Initiative (LHI) application to lower the following limits **to 40 mph**:

- Sawtry Way along its length from the A141 to the A1123
- Mere Way from the A1123 to the B1090
- A141/B1090 roundabout for 150m in all directions.

Note 1. The cost of this basic 40 Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) - estimated at £5k* - is now being 'bankrolled' solely by Community Roadwatch (financially backed by local IT Company), to provide Parish Councils with a blank canvas on which to implement future measures, such as crossing points and traffic islands, if required. CRW hopes to cover its costs from local sources.

*Estimated costs are subject to County Council ratification and may go down as well as up.
